Summer Hours for the CLUB

The CLUB Teen Center is open for 13-18 year olds from 12:00 – 5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday during the summer. Middle school hour is 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. Monday-Friday. Teens who wish to be at the Club in the morning have the option to participate in Teen Camps from 9:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m., or to sign up to be Junior Staff.

Junior Staff

This is a volunteer program for any teen (13 & up) who would like to work within the Club, gaining useful employment skills and knowledge. Teens must complete a 3-day training in order to be considered for a position in the Club, as well as daily evaluations and progress reports each time they work. Teens will be placed under the supervision of a staff member in an area of the Club based off of their skills, interests and future career goals. Teens will also participate in trainings such as Career Launch, Skills to Pay the Bills, The Professional Workshop, etc.

Middle School Hour

Middle School Hour will be every day from 1:00 - 2:00 p.m. All youth 10, 11 and 12 years old will be able to participate in the Teen Center. Older teens can participate in the Teen Center during Middle School Hour as well.

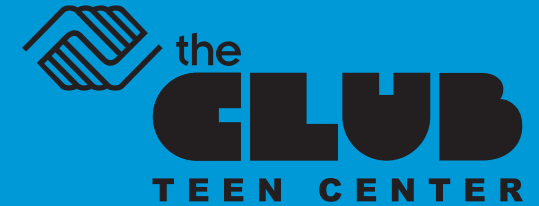

The CLUB Teen Center 411

The CLUB, a center for teens, includes a fitness center, a technology space, a theater, a lounge area and a music & drama room. The CLUB also features a large games room complete with pool tables, air hockey, ping-pong, foosball and enough video games to engage even the biggest gamer.

During the hours of 1:00 - 5:30 p.m. teens can participate in a wide variety of activities, tournaments and programs, including video games, computers, sports, music, cooking classes, and daily challenges and games.

Any teen in the building prior to 11:30 a.m. must either be in the Jr. Staff program or be signed up for a teen camp, with complete payment made.

Yearly membership fee (\$25) & any camp or field trip fees must be paid before teens can attend regular teen center hours.

Teen Summer Camps

This summer, teens have a wide variety of weeklong camps that they can attend between the hours of 9:30-11:30 a.m. every day. Camps include, but are not limited to: community service, music, technology, woodworking, theater, photography, cooking, sports, career exploration and STEM. Each camp has a fee that goes along with it, ranging in cost from \$10 to \$50. Some camps will also have age restrictions (i.e. 13-15 yrs. old, or 16-18 yrs. old). Sign up for Teen camps begins April 3, 2017.

Teens must be signed up and paid in full prior to the first day of each camp and must attend all 5 days. Cancellation must happen by the Thursday before that particular camp, otherwise no refund will be given. Teens (13-18 years old) must have a current membership to attend and be in good standing at the Club.

Some camps will take place away from the Club. Transportation will be provided and we will meet at the CLUB Teen Center before departing. Please be sure to be on time. There will be no waiting for late attendees.

Teens will be offered the opportunity to participate in an apparel sale to raise funds for camps and Full day Field trips. The sale will take place in the Spring of 2017.

Week 1: June 12-16

Camp 1: Pools & Parks Camp

Explore area parks and pools and take a full day trip to Noah's Ark in Wisconsin Dells on Thursday, June 15, from 8am-8pm. Cost \$30

Camp 2: Technology Camp

Learn the art of coding, 3-D printing, web, video and movie design, as well as other techy skills. Cost \$20

Week 2: June 19-23

Camp 1: Living to Serve - Community Service Projects Camp

Help make Oshkosh a better place by volunteering to help out at community agencies such as Habitat for Humanity, as well as help run a mobile food pantry through Feeding America. End the week with a rewarding trip to the trampoline park! *Must be 14 years old. Cost \$10

Week 3: June 26-30

Camp 1: Teen Music Camp

Explore and learn the basics of a variety of different instruments including guitar, drums and voice, as well as practice songwriting and gain an understanding of music equipment, gear and song composition. Cost \$10

Week 4: July 5-7

Camp 1: Teen Photography Camp

Learn the tricks of the photography trade, cool filters to use and how to take the very best selfies out there! Cost \$10

Week 5: July 10-14

Camp 1: Games, Puzzles and Scavenger Hunts Camp

Learn some new, popular board games, build a 3-D puzzle with your team, Geo Cache and go on a scavenger hunt in the city! Cost \$10

Camp 2: All about the Animals Camp

Learn proper handling and tricks for your pets at home, help out with rescue animals and take a zoo tour. Cost \$20

Week 6: July 17-21

Camp 1: STEM Teen Camp

Participate in a number of exciting STEM-based science experiments that will really get your brain working! This camp includes a full day trip on Thursday to the Club's Camp Radford in New London. Cost \$20

Camp 2: Cooking Teen Camp

Learn the art of cooking tasty meals from local chefs and gain useful skills that you will be able to take home with you to practice in your own kitchen! Cost \$25

Week 7: July 24-28

Camp 1: Football Bootcamp

Be coached by some of Oshkosh's top football players in this intense week full of all things football! Cost \$10

Camp 2: Painting and Graffiti Art Camp

Teens will spend time exploring their creative side through drawing, sketching, painting and making graffiti art. Cost \$20

Week 8: July 31-Aug. 4

Camp 1: Basketball Camp

Drills, skills & scrimages! We will also be playing a game against a nearby Boys & Girls Club team. Cost \$10

Camp 2: Cake & Cookie Decorating Camp

Learn the art of baking, creating, designing and decorating delicious desserts from some talented local pastry chefs. Cost \$25

Camp 1: Extreme Sports Camp
