*All participants must be interviewed by a judging panel after all materials are submitted. The judging will be conducted on **Wednesday**, **October 25**, **2023** at the Head Start building of the Boys & Girls Club of Oshkosh from **5pm - 7pm**.

*Additionally, all participants must attend the annual Youth of the Year dinner on **Thursday, October 26th, 2023**. The dinner will be at Oshkosh Convention Center at **5:30pm.** This is where the 2023-2024 Youth of the Year will be announced!
