
## 2023 Summer Report

The School District of Omro was awarded a two-year grant through the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021's ESSER III Summer School Programs. In partnership with the Boys & Girls Club of Oshkosh (BGCO), this opportunity supports out-of-school time programming from June through August of 2023 and 2024 to provide a multi-level support system regarding the academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of Oshkosh youth.

- ▶ 264 students attended summer classes at Omro Elementary school.
- ▶ 44 youth attending summer school also attended programming at the Boys & Girls Club.
- ▶ 48 youth attended educational programming through the Club to reduce summer learning loss
- ▶ 100% of students read for at least 30 minutes each day, engaged in STEM programming, and attended enriching field trips.
- ► All 5 Club staff were trained on Concious Discipline and the Boys & Girls Club of America's Behavioral Support Tool Kit.
- ▶ 100% of youth engaged in daily social-emotional learning or one-on-one/small group activies through the Club.



## About Our Program

The Boys & Girls Club of Oshkosh began offering an After-School Program in Omro during the Fall of 2021 and has since established a Summer Program. Our partnership has continued to grow to include additional collaboration to ensure that these programs best support Omro students. In June of 2023, the School District of Omro offered summer school classes for students in Kindergarten to 12th grade. Following the end of summer school classes each day, elementary students registered through the Club would then attend additional programs with Club staff. Through this state-licensed summer program, Omro Area School District students participated in a variety of programming, including arts & crafts, STEM activities, field trips, Library Club, Picnics in the Parks, and much more.
